

Gutter Race Track First Time Prep

A gravity race track that lasts for less than \$40:

Go to your local hardware or home improvement store and get the following parts:

One plastic foldable saw horse (Harbor Freight carries inexpensive versions)

Two vinyl gutter pieces 10 ft in length each

Two feet of velcro

One roll of colorful masking tape

Apply one part of the velcro to the top of the saw horse.



2 Cut a couple of pieces of the other velcro parts about 2.75 inches in length. Apply one piece to the bottom of each gutter about 1 inch from the gutter end as shown.



3 Use a piece of tape or a marker to indicate a start line inside both gutter pieces about 8 inches from the gutter top.
